Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL) at Notre Dame College



VCAL is an accredited Senior Secondary Certificate undertaken in Years 11 and 12. VCAL is based on the idea of “hands on” learning also known as applied learning. Students who do VCAL are likely to be interested in completing an apprenticeship, studying a TAFE course or going directly into the workforce once they finish school.

To successfully complete VCAL, students must complete four compulsory strands:

- Literacy and Numeracy Skills
- Personal Development Skills (PDS)
- Work Related Skills (WRS)
- Industry Specific Skills

At Notre Dame College, students are automatically enrolled at an Intermediate level in Year 11 and at senior level in Year 12. These levels can be adjusted during the year to suit individual student needs and abilities.
