Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA) Requirements

Students must **satisfactorily** complete a minimum of 16 Units including:

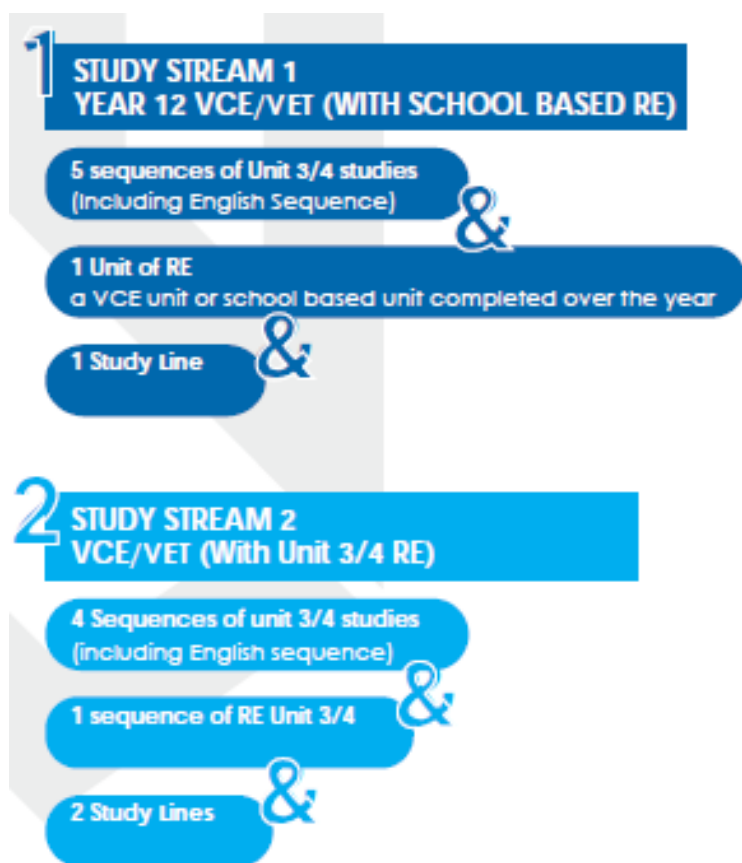
- Three units from the English group of subjects *plus*
- Three other Unit 3/4 sequences (6 units).

The 16 units may include an unlimited number of VCE/VET units.

Any other VCE or VCE/VET units may be chosen to make up the program, ensuring that the balance of subjects suits the student's post-VCE pathway.

For the purposes of obtaining an ATAR (Australian Tertiary Admission Rank) score, students must complete a Unit 3/4 sequence from the English group and at least three other scored Unit 3/4 sequences, scored VET studies or 10% non-scored VET studies

In Year 12, students have two study stream options:



In selecting your 2018 subjects, it is best to consider studies that:

- You are currently enrolled in,
- Interest you and you are good at,
- Will help you get into the University or TAFE courses you want to do, or
- Lead to a job that interests you.
