



## NDC Year 10 Semester 1 Exams

Monday, 20 June to Friday, 24 June 2022.

### ***Compulsory for all students.***

- Normal Year 10 classes will NOT be running therefore, students are only required to come to school for their exams.
- Students who accelerate a Unit 1/2 subject will be required to attend the exams, not the fast-tracking class.
- Whilst at school for an exam ALL usual school rules apply.
- You must have your student ID card with you for all exams.
- **No mobile phones, smart watches, Fitbits etc. or other electronic devices are allowed in the exam room. THESE WILL BE CONFISCATED!**
- All exams have 10 minutes reading time and 90 minutes writing time. You must remain seated and quiet in the hall/room until the end of the exam session.
- Arrive 15 minutes before the exam start time so you can all be seated and ready to start on time.
- Once you enter the exam room you must not communicate with another student for any reason.
- If you need assistance of any kind please remain seated, put your hand up and wait quietly until a supervisor comes to you.
- Some students will have a clash between two or more Year 10 exams; complete one of the exams at the timetabled time, then attend one of the clash sessions to complete the other exam. You do not need to book in for a clash; you can just turn up, tell a teacher what exam you are doing, and they will get your exam paper.
- Exam Revision Guidelines (ERG) will be available on the College website under Quicklinks/Semester 1 Exams. Must read!
- Only the *Allowed Materials* listed on the ERG can be taken into the exam room. E.g. If the exam states a *scientific calculator only* is allowed you will not be permitted to use a CAS calculator.
- Pens, pencils, erasers etc. must be in a clear pencil case or zip lock type bag.
- Water bottles must be clear and have the label removed.
- A classroom will be allocated as a quiet study room each day of exams (check the student bulletin).
- Marked exams will be available for collection early in Semester 2. The details will be published in the student bulletin.
- Neat, casual dress is allowed.
