STUDENT RECEPTION

Student Reception is located on the Northside of Knight Street. To get here you cross at the lights, like you are going to the Library (there's a video to help with this) and then you turn right in the courtyard when you get past the Chapel.

LEAVE PASS

If you need to leave the school for a medical appointment during school hours, your parents need to write a note requesting a leave pass containing the following information:

- *Students Name*
- *Reason for Leave Pass*
- *Time of departure and Return (if child is not returning the note will need to state this)*
- *Parents Signature*

In the morning when you get to school, take the note from your parents to you Head of House. Around 5 minutes before the time you need to leave, show the note to your class teacher. Take everything back to your locker and then only take with you what you will need. Go to student reception and they will sign you out.

UNIFORM PASS

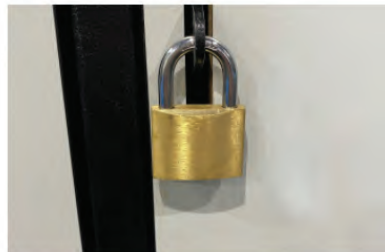
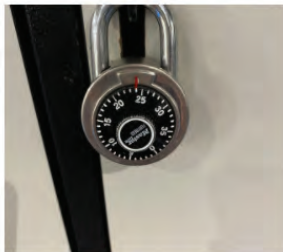
If, for whatever reason, you cannot wear your assigned uniform for that day, you will need a note from home including the following information:

- *Students Name*
- *Reason for being out of uniform*
- *Parents Signature*

In the morning when you get to school, take the note from your parents to your Head of House.

LOCKERS

You will be provided with a locker to keep your things in, but you will need to provide a lock. All lockers **MUST** be locked throughout the day. Any of the types of locks below are fine to use, however if you have one with a key it's a good idea to give a spare key to your Head of House.



TIP: Keep your locker neat and tidy!

One of the best ways to make sure you get to your classes on time is to keep your locker clean and tidy.

You can put a copy of your timetable on the inside of your locker door so that you can check what classes you have when, and to help you remember what books you need to bring to each class.



WHAT TO BRING TO CLASSES

For each class you will need to bring your computer, planner, pencil case as well as the books you will need for your classes

FOR EXAMPLE: If you had English and Maths for period 1 & 2, you would bring your computer, planner, maths books, english books and your pencil case. Bring both periods' books to your first class, so you don't have to go back to your locker in between classes



THE CANTEEN

The school Canteen is open at recess and lunchtime and is located on the South Side of the Knight Street Campus (same side of the road as your Pastoral Group Rooms).

LUNCH ORDERS - If you would like to place a lunch order, go to the canteen either before school or at recess. There is a box (see photo below) where there will be paper bags and pens. Once you have written down your lunch order, put the money into the bag, fold it and then put the bag into the box.



Please make sure that you line up in the allocated Year 7 line, there are signs on the windows so you know which line to go to. If you are ordering food and you have NOT placed a lunch order, line up at the window shown above.
